The Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań, Poland, is currently looking for a post-doctoral researcher to work part-time (50%) on a Horizon 2020 project NoVaMigra from

 1 December 2018 until 31 March 2021.



Requirements:

- ▶ Ph.D. in social sciences (anthropology, sociology, psychology, political science, geography, history, language studies, migration studies)
- ▶ At least one year of experience in migration studies, including research and publication
- ▶ Fluency in English and Polish (both in speech and writing)
- ▶ Very good communication skills
- ▶ Very good organizational skills
- ▶ Ability to travel within Poland (Warsaw, Poznań, Gdańsk, Wrocław, other locations), Hungary, other countries to conduct field research, organize stakeholder meetings, and participate in research team meetings
- ▶ Knowledge of Hungarian is a bonus



Specific tasks:

- ▶ Desk study of pertinent legislation and regulations
- ▶ Literature review
- ▶ Preparing and conducting field research
- ▶ Organizing brain storming sessions
- ▶ Participation in project meetings (about 2 per year)
- ▶ Co-organization of project meetings in Poznan
- ▶ Close cooperation with the PI from AMU, Dr. Izabella Main and Visiting Professor Dr. Elzbieta Gozdzik
- ▶ Administrative and organizational tasks related to the project

The position will commence on 1 December 2018 and it is foreseen as a part-time job (50%). A monthly gross salary (PI brutto brutto) is around 2500 Euros per month (full-time equivalent) depending on the agreed scope of tasks and working hours. The position is based on a contract of employment (umowa o pracę) at Adam Mickiewicz University.
